

Introduction

The SceneStation Demo Kit is a complete “plug-n-play” package that’s great for demonstrating SceneStation’s capabilities. Use this kit for evaluating SceneStation in your projects, learning how to program SceneStation, or for showing to clients.

Normally, SceneStation is sold as only the wall-switch unit with the flush wall plate cover. In this case, the user is responsible for wiring the power and DMX circuits. The demo kit comes ready to use, with the SceneStation mounted to a portable electrical box with the wiring already included to a set of XLR and power-input pigtails. Just attach the 12VDC power supply and connect something to the DMX jacks and you’re ready to use the demo SceneStation.

What’s Included

1. SceneStation
2. Portable Enclosure with Power and DMX pigtails
3. Programmer’s IR Remote Control
4. 12VDC Power Supply
5. Carrying Case



Getting Started

Attach the included 12VDC power supply to the SceneStation demo package. It should immediately “turn on”. If you’d like to control some DMX fixtures, attach them to the Female XLR jack.

The SceneStation demo is shipped from the factory with a demo program already in memory. This is SceneStation’s “Demo Show #2”. A sheet is included that gives the specific details about this show. In general, however, it’s an example that is used with RGB type fixtures. The first button on SceneStation simply toggles “All White” on and off. The second button is set up to select a solid color. Each time the button is pressed, it advances to the next solid color. The third, fourth and fifth buttons all run sample animating patterns (or chases). The fifth button takes advantage of more advanced programming that automatically advances from one chase to another.

You’re welcome to change or edit the program in the SceneStation. If you’d like to erase memory and return to the demo show, press **EDIT + OPTION + 982** on the remote control. Or, if you’d like to erase memory completely and start with a blank show, press **EDIT + OPTION + 989**.
